#### WEEKLY REHEARSAL ATTENDANCE

- •Excused absences are determined through the main office and include illness or a family emergency only 2 parent notes allowed (school policy)
- •Sickness is only excused if you have a fever or are throwing up (a headache, my foot hurts, etc. is not an excuse)
- •Work is not an excuse for students to miss practice or a performance
- •Regularly scheduled doctor's appointments are not excused (Example: Eye doctor, orthodontist etc.)
- •Some exceptions are made for once in a lifetime events but must be approved by Mr. Iddings way in advance (ex. Family weddings etc.)







